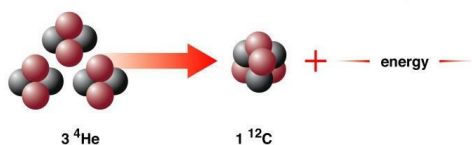


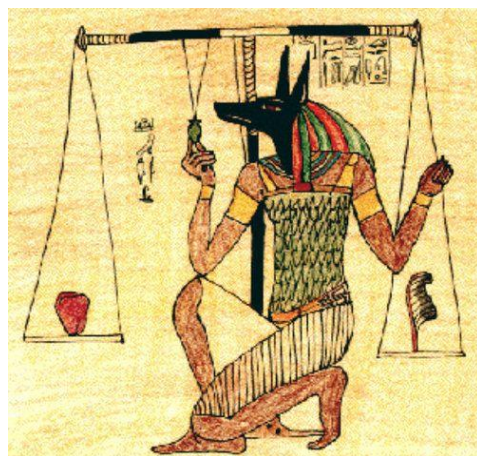
Frau Dulent on the Holy Trinity:
